Safety and privacy are key issues where children are concerned, and these issues are front and center on the note2home.com website. "Only a parent with a password has access to messages surrounding any particular student."

Note2home.com is online and available to parents and schools now.

Among the many features **note2home.com** offers are: Online discussion boards, online permission slips which parents "sign" with password approval, online bill-paying for tuition, fees (much safer than an envelope containing cash or check), and of course total connectivity to your child's school and social networks.
